TOPIC: 'Wh' questions and question words

Divide the class into groups of six and have the students sit in a circle.

Give each group a set of cards and an envelope. Ask the students to shuffle the cards and deal out four each, leaving the envelope in the center of the circle.

On each card, students use the 'Wh' question word to write a question about another student in the group that they know the answer for.

The students then write the answer in sentence form underneath the question in the space provided.

Example:

Question: What kind of films does Anna like?

Answer: She likes westerns and thrillers.

Students then fold the card as indicated, concealing the answer, and put it in the envelope.

When everyone has finished writing, students compete against each other to answer the questions.

Students take it in turns to draw a card from the envelope and read the question to the group members.

The student who is the subject of the question is not allowed to answer.

The first student to put up their hand can answer the question.

The student's answer is checked against the one concealed behind the question.

If the answer matches, the respondent wins the card. If not, someone else may try to answer.

If no one knows the answer, the student who read the question discloses the answer and sets the card aside.

When all the questions have been asked, students count up their cards.

The student with the most cards wins the game.
