Information Exchange

Tell the students that they are going to exchange personal information about four people in order to complete missing information in a chart.

As an example, write the following on the board:

	Brad
Where / from?	America
Where / live?	Los Angeles
How old?	53
Single or married?	married, 4 children
What / job?	actor
Where / work?	film studio
What / hobby?	basketball

Elicit the present simple 'Wh' questions and answers from the prompts and explain that the students are going to use these questions in the activity.

Where is Brad from? He is from America.

Where does he live? He lives in Los Angeles.

How old is he? He is 53 years old.

Is he single or married? He is married with 4 children.

What is his job? He is an actor.

Where does he work? He works in a film studio.

What is his hobby? He plays basketball.

Next, divide the students into pairs (A and B).

Give each student a corresponding worksheet.

Students then take it in turns to ask the present simple 'Wh' questions from the prompts to their partner and complete the chart with their answers.

When the students have finished, review the information with the class.
